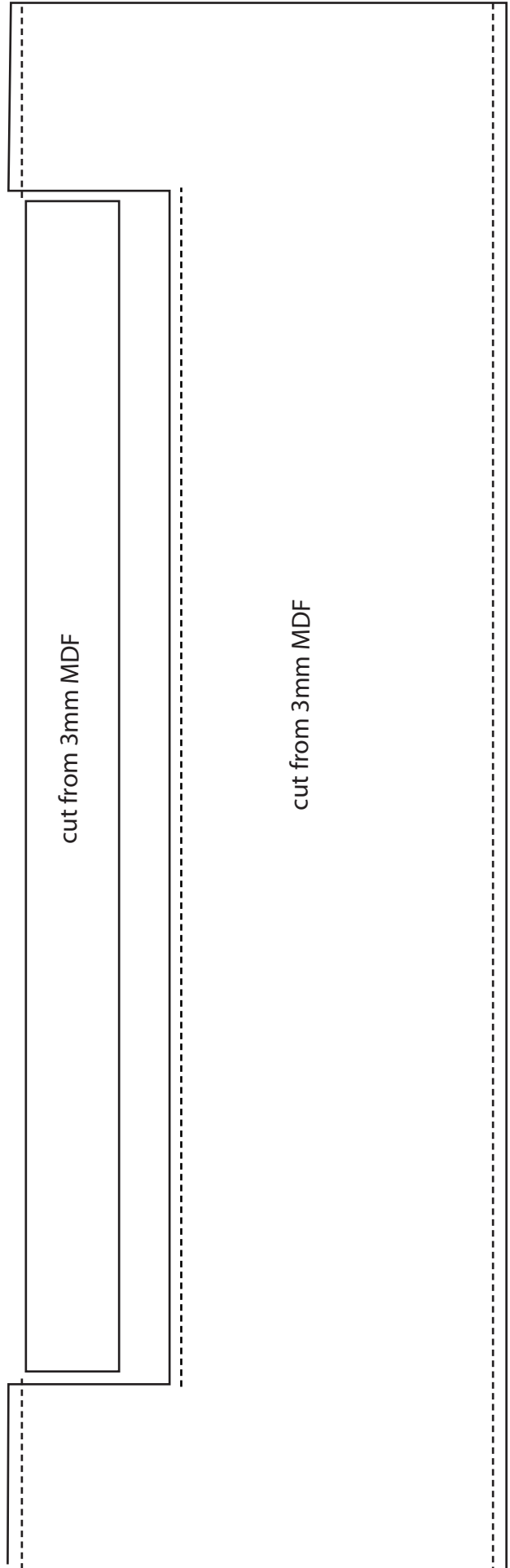
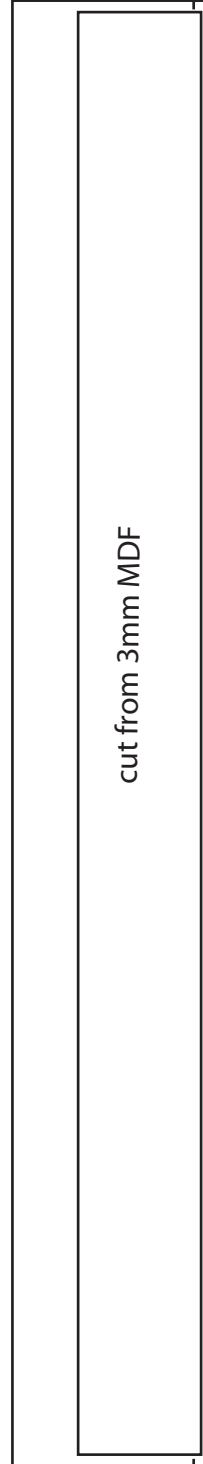
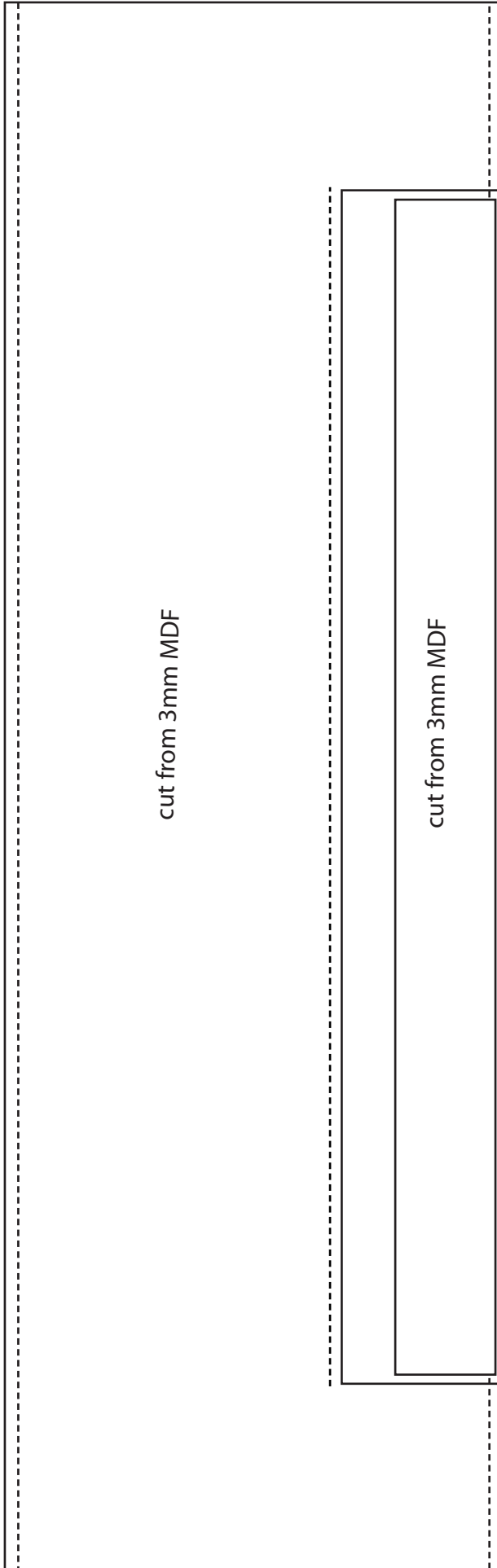
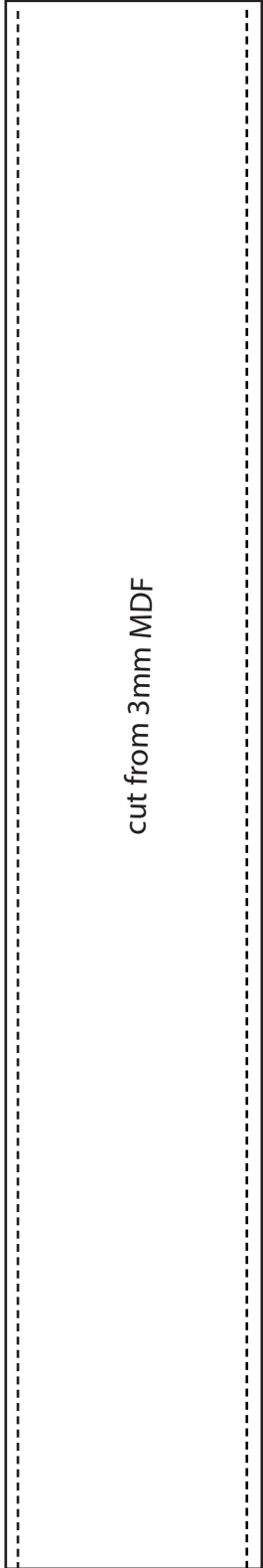


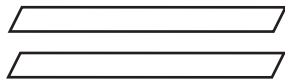
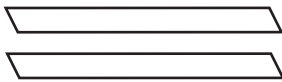
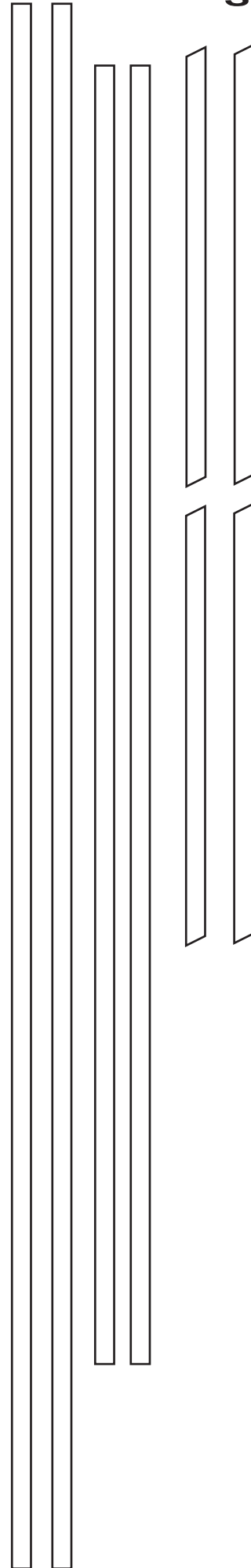
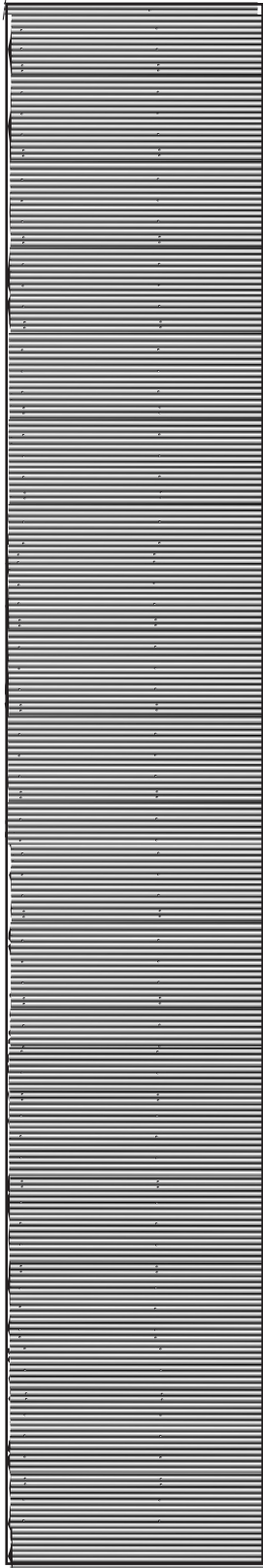
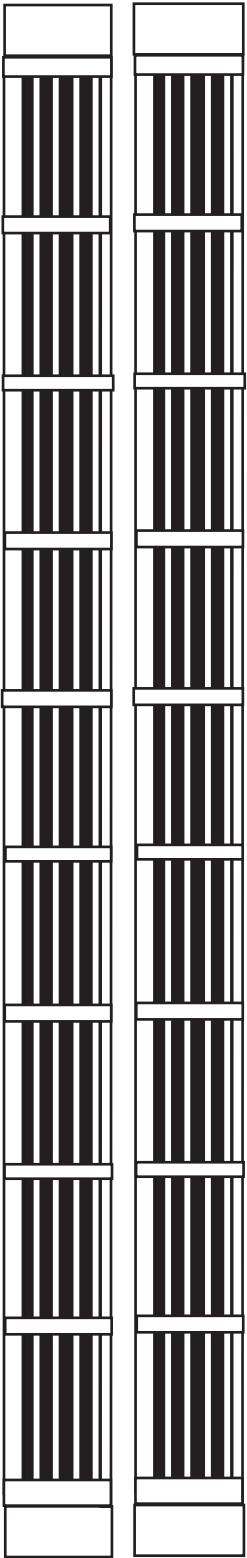
Corrugated iron small engine shed often used in remote Queensland yards

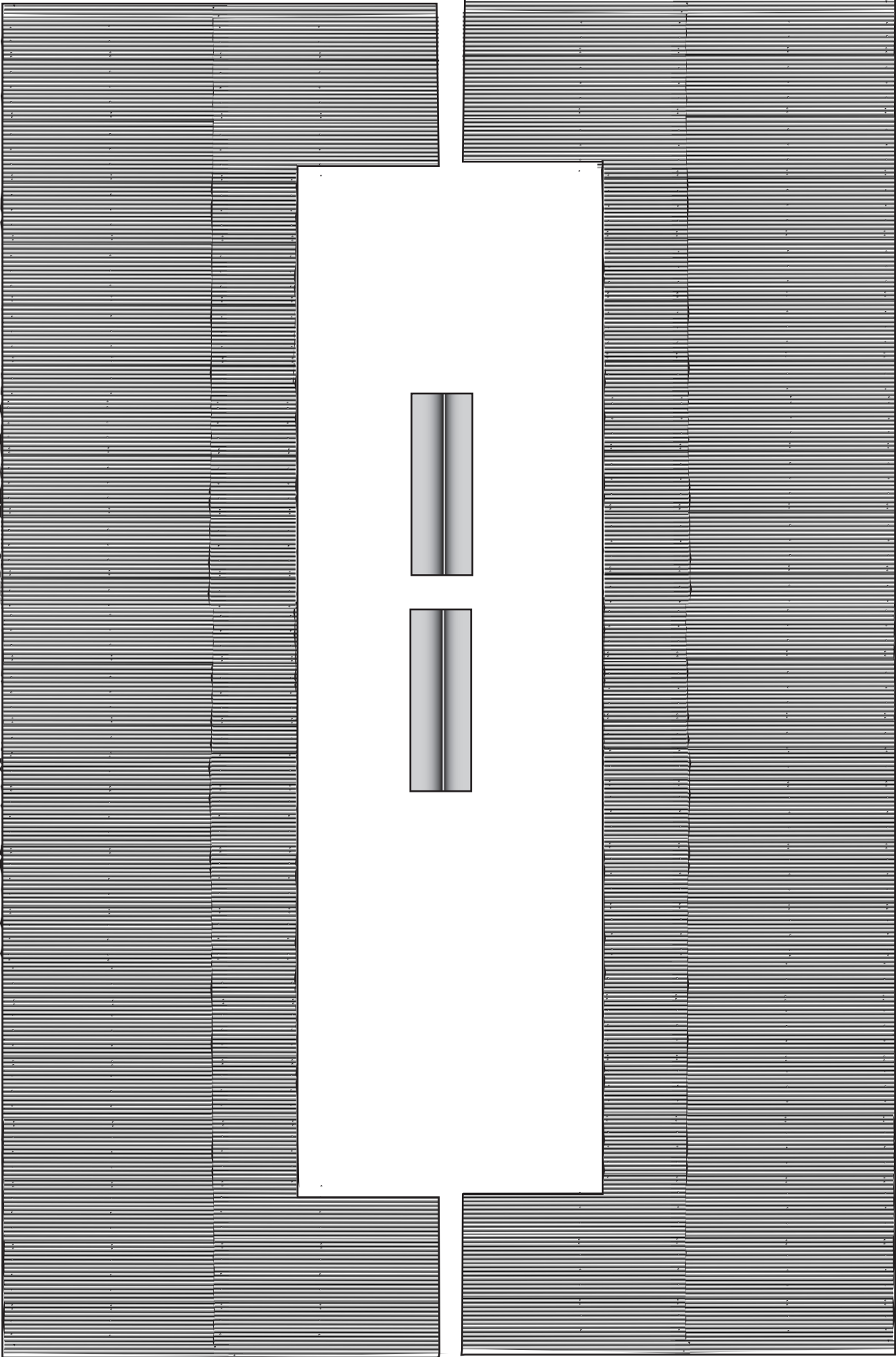


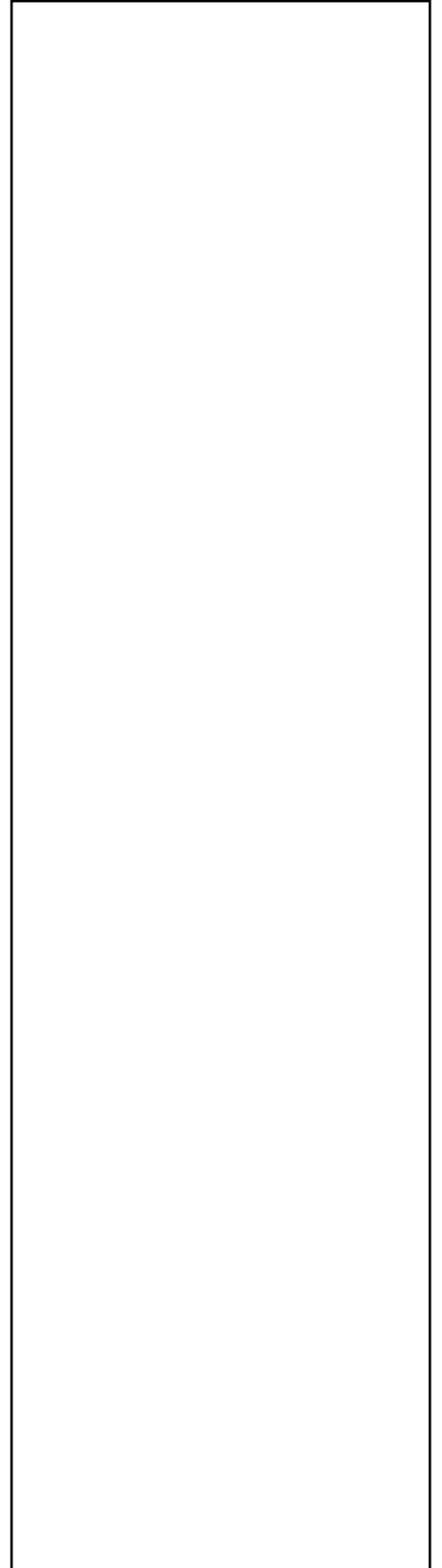
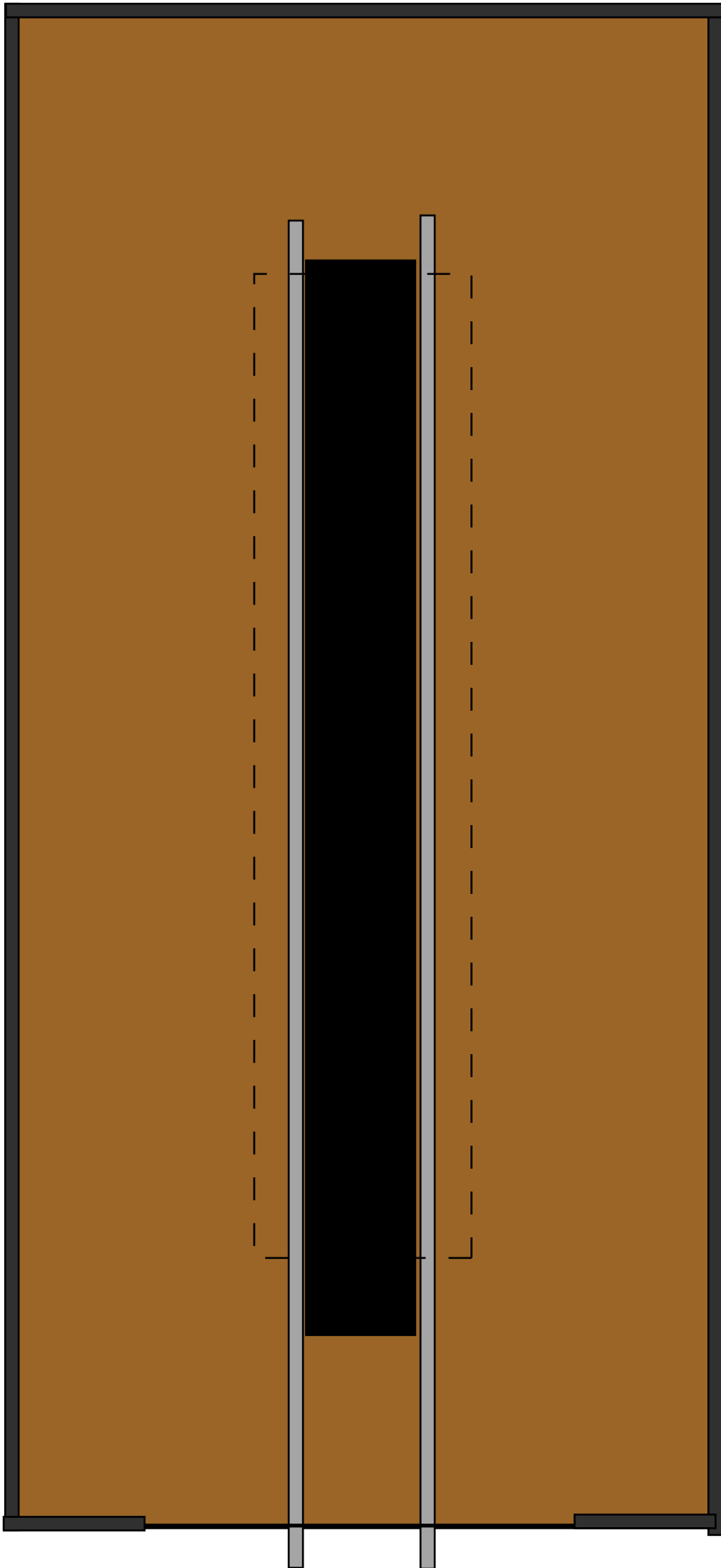
Cut parts from 3mm MDF or thick card  
Assemble as shown  
Fold doors around card  
Cut facias from thin card or wood glue to edges of roof  
Gluing the paper Lining to the inside first and wrapping around edges of windows  
glue windows (clear) over openings  
Glue outer paper covering carefully fitting around windows





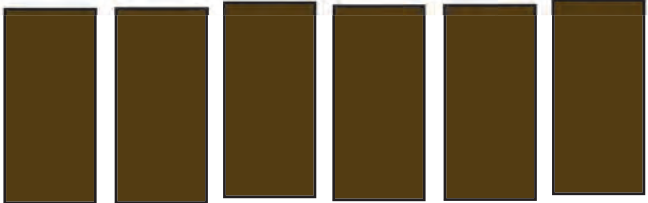
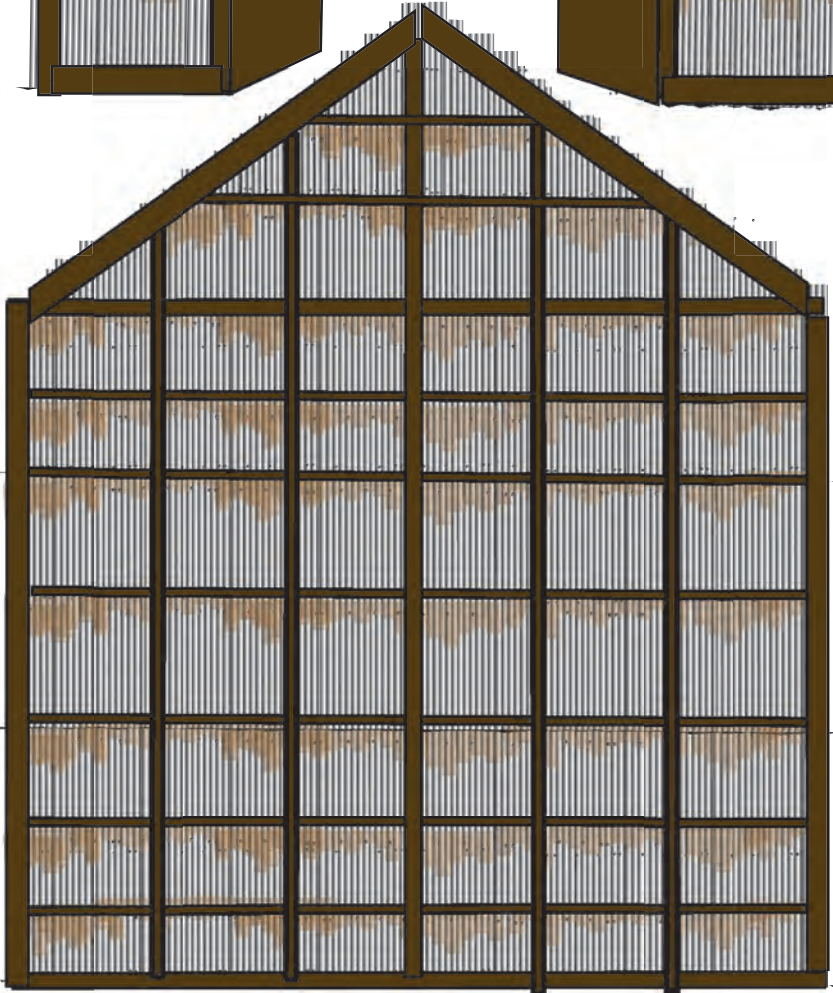
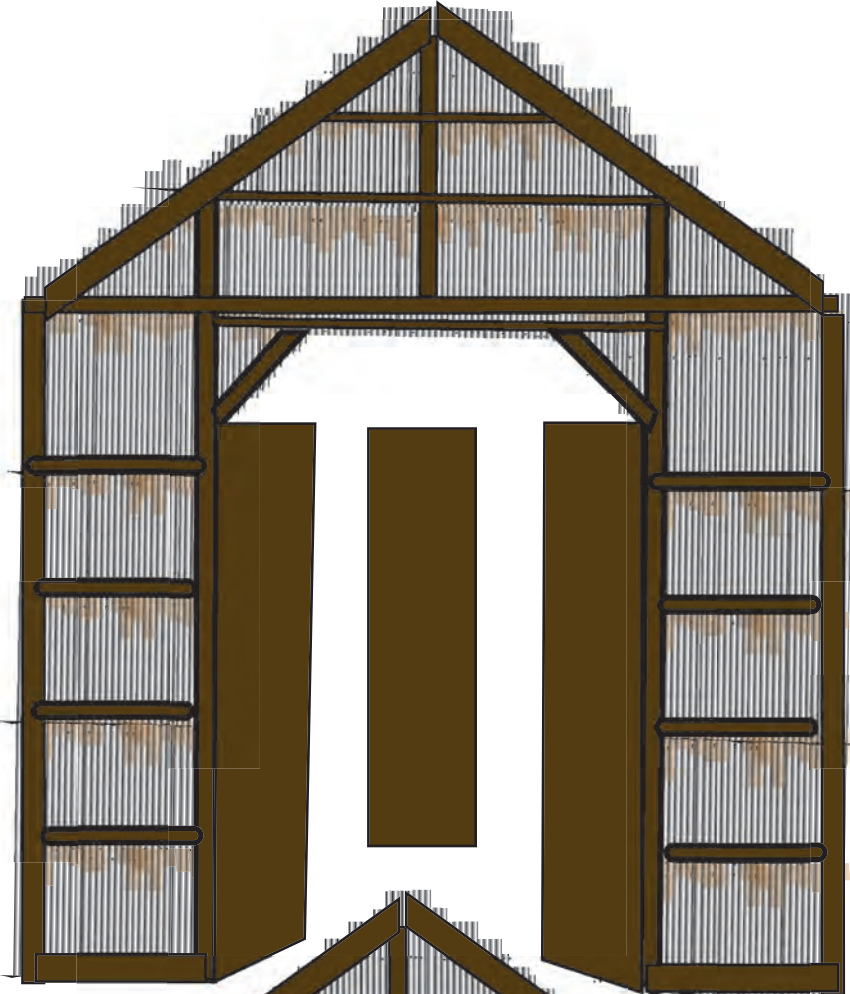


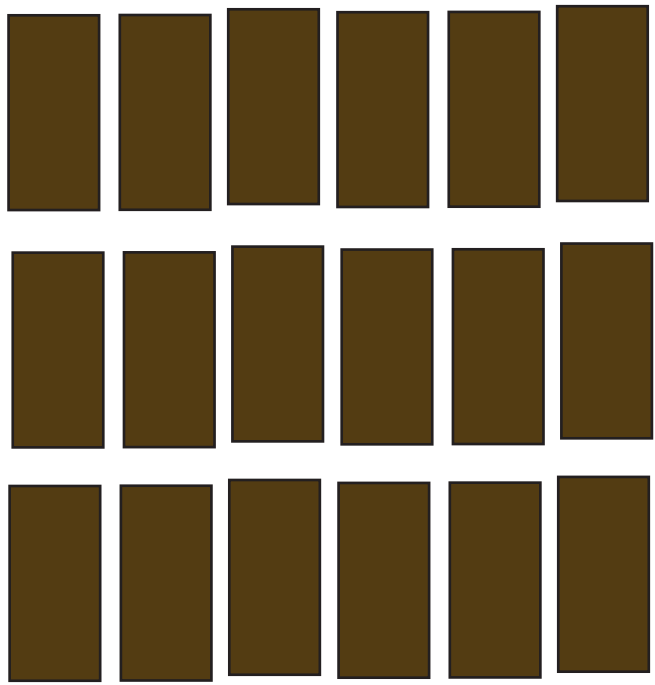




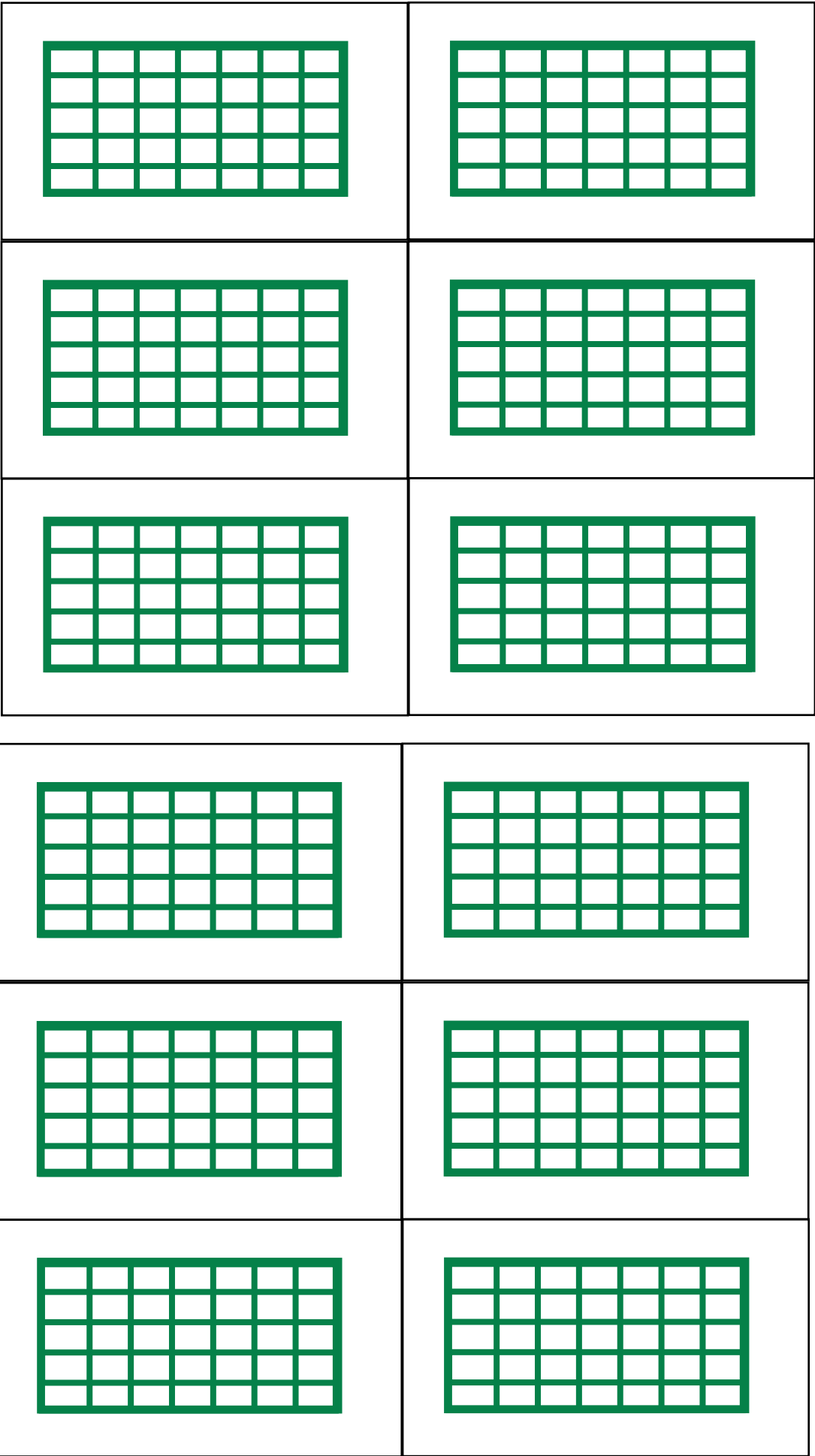
