



**YOU CAN SEE** Douglas Fir trees, five feet in diameter and 180 feet tall, which were already 100 years old when Capt. James Cook made his first voyage to Vancouver Island in 1778.

**YOU CAN RIDE** on a mile-long, narrow-gauge railway, winding through the trees, over fills and under bridges, and crossing a bay on Somenos Lake upon a 300-foot trestle.
